All entries must be submitted by December 31, 2021 at 11:59 p.m. Draws will take place and winners notified by January 15, 2022. No purchase is necessary to enter or win. Entry into this Contest constitutes your acceptance of the official rules and regulations, as follows:

The Contest

The Contest is sponsored by Kawartha Credit Union, 14 Hunter Street East, PO Box 116, Peterborough, Ontario K9J 6Y5. The Contest start date is October 18, 2021 at 9:00 a.m. Eastern Standard Time and the Contest end date is December 31, 2021 at 5:00 p.m. Eastern Standard Time. All entries must be received within the Contest Period to be eligible to win.

Eligibility

The Contest is open to all members of Kawartha Credit Union who are residents of Ontario 18 years of age or older on the date of contest entry. Employees, directors, contractors, agents or representatives of Kawartha Credit Union, or its affiliates, agencies, distribution companies, third party vendors, or any person who is a member of the immediate families of such employees (parent, sibling, child or any person residing in the same household) are not eligible to win.

How to Enter

To participate in the Contest, the entrant must update all of their personal information and all sections of their consent form. This may be done through online banking, by calling our Contact Centre at 1-855-670-0510, or while at a branch during the contest period.

Prize

There will be one (1) prize awarded of a \$500 40-month GIC.

Determination of Winner

There will be one (1) ballot for each qualifying contest entrant. A random draw will be held by the Contest judges at 14 Hunter Street East, Peterborough, Ontario, to select one (1) contest entrant from among all eligible entries received during the contest period. The prize will be paid out by February 1, 2022 as a deposit to the winning member's demand account. In the case of joint accounts, the prize will be awarded to the primary account holder. Winners must be members in good standing at time of draw.

Winner Notification

The winner will be verified and then contacted by a Kawartha Credit Union representative by telephone. Any selected entrant who cannot be contacted (or who fails to respond to telephone messages) within seven (7) days of Kawartha Credit Union's first attempt to contact such them may, at the sole discretion of Kawartha Credit Union, be declared disqualified and ineligible to win. The contest judges reserve the right, in such event, to select at random another entrants whom they shall attempt to contact, and who shall be subject to disqualification in the same manner.

Before being awarded a prize, the winner will be required to sign a Declaration and Release Form, stating that:
